1. Introduction

- 1.1 Our website uses cookies to enhance your experience.
- 1.2 By using our website and agreeing to this policy, you consent to our use of cookies in accordance with its terms.

2. About Cookies

- 2.1 A cookie is a small file containing an identifier (letters and numbers) sent by a web server to your browser.
- 2.2 Cookies can be "persistent" (stored until expiry or deletion) or "session" (expire when the browser is closed).
- 2.3 Cookies do not typically contain personal information, but the data we store may be linked to the information stored in cookies.
- 2.4 Cookies help websites identify and track users as they navigate different pages and return to the site.

3. Our Use of Cookies

- 3.1 We use both session and persistent cookies on our website.
- 3.2 The cookies are used for the following purposes:
 - (a) Recognizing your computer when you visit the website.
 - (b) Tracking your navigation to improve user experience.

4. Analytics Cookies

- 4.1 We use **Google Analytics** to monitor website traffic.
- 4.2 Google Analytics uses cookies to generate statistical data about website usage.
- 4.3 The analytics cookies used include: _ga, _gat, __utma, __utmt, __utmb, __utmc, __utmz, __utmv.

5. Blocking Cookies

- 5.1 Most browsers allow you to block cookies. For example:
 - (a) In **Internet Explorer**, use the "Tools" > "Internet Options" > "Privacy" settings.
 - (b) In Firefox, go to "Tools" > "Options" > "Privacy", and select "Custom settings for history."
 - (c) In **Chrome**, go to "Settings" > "Advanced" > "Content settings" and block cookies.
- 5.2 Blocking cookies may negatively affect your experience on our website.

6. Deleting Cookies

- 6.1 You can delete cookies already stored on your computer. For example:
 - (a) In Internet Explorer, manually delete cookie files.
 - (b) In **Firefox**, go to "Tools" > "Options" > "Privacy" > "Show Cookies" > "Remove All Cookies."
 - (c) In **Chrome**, go to "Settings" > "Advanced" > "Clear browsing data" > "Cookies and other site data."
